<u>Math</u>: Kindergarteners continue to deepen their knowledge of numbers from 10-20 or that a teen number is 10 ones and some ones. Students are working on counting by 10's to 100 and writing numerals correctly. Students are also studying the skills of addition and subtraction through composing (putting together) and decomposing (taking apart) numbers 0-10.

<u>Literacy</u>: Students are learning about persuasive writing by including facts to support their opinions while they write.

<u>Social Studies</u>: Kindergarteners are learning about how to be caretakers of our plantet Earth. Students will also learn about sea creatures, tidepools, and the ocean habitats.

<u>Science</u>: Our Ocean unit explores many different types of ocean animals from barnacles, snails, to whales.
