Dear Silver Hill Families,

I apologize that this is a late week newsletter, but there is quite a bit happening so I wanted to have all the updates!

I have had a few questions from parents/guardians regarding our safety drills. We use the HPS district wide protocols for our drills, and our entire staff has been trained in both a hard lock down procedure and ALICE (students evacuate the building) through Haverhill Public Schools. Silver Hill has it's own fire drill plan per the configuration of our building and grounds, practiced frequently both with and without the fire department present. As part of this drill, all staff are aware of the safety points and check in points. We also have an evacuation plan with Consentino. We will continue to be vigilant in checking everyone into the office, regardless of it we know you. Please do not enter the school and not sign in, even if you are just dropping something off for your child. You will be asked to sign in both for a photo pass, and a sign in book. These precautions are in place to keep our children safe. Thank you in advance for following his system.

We received great news this week from Assistant Superintendent Fulgoni reiterating Superintendent Scully's agreement that those students with older siblings currently at Silver Hill will be able to attend the Silver Hill kindergarten. HPS registration has been notified of this final decision. We will be sending home a notice to all families asking if you have a kindergartner coming next year, so we can begin to plan our classroom numbers. The second kindergarten information night will be held on March 27, 6:00-7:00, HHS Library.

We've had a great response to our Dr. Seuss Night for grades K, 1, 2 tonight, March 1, 6:00 - 7:30. Mrs. Alves and Mrs. Perez have been busy preparing for this fun family night! I'm looking forward to seeing you there!

Tomorrow, March 2nd is Dr. Seuss's birthday and in celebration grades K, 1, and 2 will have special guest readers from the Exchange Club at the high school. The list of readers isn't finalized yet, but I know we'll have several Silver Hill alumni coming back to read! It's always extra special for our students to have the "older kids", and sometimes older siblings, come back and visit!

Also on Friday, March 2, Grade 5 students will attend a presentation called "Think Before You Text", held at Consentino. The presentation will include warnings about cyber bullying and the possible

dangers of texting and social media. I appreciate Consentino including our students in this important topic and encourage you to have your child share information that he/she learned during this assembly.

Grades 3, 4, and 5 are looking forward to the VIP Dance on March 9. Flyer is attached. Get on your dancing shoes!
