5d) Development Committee:

Ms. Desmarais states that the development committee will be moving meetings to bi-monthly rather than weekly. Ms. Desmarais states she has uploaded a PR policy dr aft to google docs. Ms. Desmarais made a motion to table the PR policy in the in terest of time. Ms. Gilman sec onded, passed all in f avor.

6) Charter Renewal Proceedings

a. Update HEA vote/support

• Ms. Gilman discussed mee ting with she and Ms. Shepher d and Lisa Begle y. It was determined that the HEA vote for SHHMCS renewal must be completed prior to going to school committee meeting which are typically cancelled in the summer. An HEA vote will take place on 4/27, the vote will determine whether the HEA vote for charter approval can be held at SHHMCS. Ms. Gilman further states that the HEA vote to approve the charter must occur soon after the vote on 4/27.

o 6b. Consider inno vation school conversion

- Ms. Gilman states that if the majority v ote of the HEA is against the charter renewal, then the board must decide to convert to an innovation school. Ms. Gilman e xplained how the Amesbury Innovative High School did this r ecently.
- Ms. Gilman explains how HHS is in the bott om 10% of level 3 and in danger of moving to level 4. If SHHMCS is inno vative school or chart er school, then SHHMCS isn't implic ated as a level 4.
- Ms. Gilman states she feels strongly that the school should remain a charter. Ms. Shepher d
 expressed that the board, faculty and staff should also consider the bene fits of conversion
 school as some faculty at the meeting expressed concern over becoming a conversion school.
 Ms. Burns added that faculty may benefit from Q&A session to gain a deeper under standing of
 the pros and cons of both. Ms. Gilman v olunteers to explain benefit of charter renewal vs.
 conversion to SHHMCS.
- MS. Gilman then r ecapped what the union reps need to do for charter renewal: such as recap how the board goals etc. are met. Each grade level rep: needs to recap what was done, assessments, F&P and math results.
- Ms. Desmarais questions a clarification of exactly what vote is occurring on 4/27. Ms. Burns clarifies that the HEA reps from SHHMCS will give update to other union reps about the charter renewal. Ms. Shepher d expresses her concern that union reps will be versed to answer

- questions at the meeting of the other union reps from other schools. 4 reps from SHHMCS.
- Ms. Shepher d states that 6 schools have no reps, SHHMCS and HHS have 4. Seventeen people will be at the meeting on 4/27 to decide whether vote should be held at SHHMCS.
- Ms. Gilman states that the 4 union reps have 15 minutes to present the argument for why the vote should occur here at SHHMCS. The vote to hold the vote for charter renewal approval at SHHMCS will then occur.
- Ms. Gilman states her concern that time is running low to get the vote passed and proceed with the charter renewal prior to the deadline.
- Ms. Desmarais further questions whether the quorum is of those who sho w up to vote or of all voting HEA members. Ms. Shepher d states Lisa Begley has not clarified this y et with the lawyers.
- Ms. Desmarais questions how the schools without union r eps are going to get the word out for voting. Ms. Shepher d clarifies that Ms. Begley will be the point person to speak to those schools.
- Discussion by Ms. Gilman about the bene fits of the chart er school to families such as free all day K. Ms. Desmar ais questions whether free all day K will be no long er if converted innovative school. Ms. Shepher d states that school will write own prospectus which will include free all day K.
- Ms. Shepher d states that if SHHMCS becomes an innovative school, then the school will receive level funding and this will be en forced by DESI.
- Ms. Shepher d further states that innovative school does not r equire HEA support.
- Ms. Gilman explains the bene fits to city of being an inno vative school such as relieving congestion at Consentino school, and becoming neighborhood school.
- Ms. Tracey questions whether a board is not needed in inno vative school model. Ms. Shepherd states the school may keep a board but do not need to, but maintaining a board is beneficial to maintain the non- profit foundation.
- Ms. Gilman states would be beneficial to go to meeting on 4/27 and make a motion to have the vote there immediately.
- Ms. Burns recapped recent faculty meeting on 4/3/17 in which w as discussed procedure for charter renewal and responsibilities of teachers in the process. Discussion ensued about teachers not having a role in the first charter renewal process and they will be taking on these responsibilities going forward.
- Ms. Gilman handed out CHAR T analysis handout and reviewed. Which states numbers are
 inaccurate for economically disadvantaged which was reported to DESI. I.e....new
 kindergarteners for this school year not reflected.
- According to desi site 40% economically disadvantaged(free & reduced lunch).
- Ms. Gilman and Ms. Shepher d reviewed with board CHART Enrollment & Indicators. (see attached).

OTHER/ PTO:

- Ms. Tracey questioned outcome of PTO meeting and new by-laws.
- Ms. Sanchez then recapped PTO meeting and that the Barnstable, MA by-laws will be used as a template/guideline for SHHMCS by-laws.
- Ms. Gilman states that at May meeting the board will review the PTO bylaws.
